Campbellsport/Eden Area Alcohol License Training Session on January 26

On Thursday, January 26, 2012 at 1:30pm the Village of Campbellsport Police Department and Fond du Lac County Sheriff's Office, in partnership with REACH Underage Drinking in Eden in Campbellsport, will be hosting an alcohol license training session at no cost. This valuable training is open to all and any alcohol license holders in the Campbellsport and Eden area- this includes anyone with a bartender's license. Topics such as checking for ID's, criminal and civil liabilities and over-serving issues will be covered. There will also be time for questions.

The alcohol license training will take place at the Campbellsport Public Library, located on 220 Helena Street, Campbellsport, WI 53010, in the basement meeting room. Mark Jurgella, Special Agent for the Alcohol and Tobacco Enforcement Unit will conduct the training.

Alcohol license trainings are recommended as one of the ways to decrease youth access at retail establishments and aid in retailer compliance with alcohol licensing laws. "By increasing the knowledge and awareness of the license holders, they will be able to make more informed decisions when carding youth and serving alcohol," stated Deputy Dean Schelinske of the Fond du Lac County Sheriff's Office.
