If something is found, parents and students should have talking points and resources for where to go next.</p> <p><u>Treatment</u> – Continuing work on action plan and analyzing data.</p> <p><u>Harm Reduction</u> – Focusing on opioid overdose data. 7 from Ripon PD, 2 from ARCW. Compared to 4 from last year from Ripon PD. Focus on marketing, advertising making sure at risk people are reached. Second focus encouraging the use of clean supplies. Mobile exchange no longer serving Fond du Lac area, so brainstorming other ways we can accomplish this.</p> <p><u>Law Enforcement</u> – The last couple of overdoses. Stressed the trauma on family. One overdose of a tavern. A situation at the hospital, where someone was dropped off.
