Distance between where they live and the treatment facility. Data Points: survey, key informant interviews</p> <p>Contributing factors: cost assumed by the City. Data Points: contracts, city council</p> <p>Policy Change or modification: extend by contract the hours public transportation is available. Physical design: taxi stop similar to a bus stop. More signage, downtown, online, stores, businesses. On call system for drivers. Changing consequences incentivize the taxi by providing funds for the persons in need of transportation to and from treatment. E.g. voucher/punch cards Enhancing access and reducing barriers increase hours and availability of public transportation. Changing treatment times to accommodate public transportation. Provide information about the services in Ripon. Phone app, call button, contact information to use call a taxi. Providing support Assist the taxi service agency with training, information. Enhancing skills Trainings at hospitals, L.E., and taxi services.
