

Sharps Disposal

Please DO NOT dispose of needles, syringes and lancets in the Drug Drop Box

With so many people managing their healthcare needs at home, several healthcare organizations now offer services that dispose of community members' needles, syringes and lancets safely.



In Fond du Lac County, Agnesian HealthCare and Aurora Health Care offer residents sharps collection and disposal programs that help keep the community safe.

Residents requiring the use of sharps can receive needle disposal containers at various locations and should see the instructions below for safe sharps disposal.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Residents requiring the use of sharps can receive free red needle disposal containers from: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Agnesian Pharmacies & Prescription Centers ○ Fond du Lac Regional Clinic Division Street Campus main entrance (through valet parking staff or the clinic information desk assistants) ○ Fond du Lac Regional Clinic satellite offices ○ Ripon Medical Center ○ Waupun Memorial Hospital • When the red needle disposal container is full, participants can drop it off at any of the locations listed on the back of this page during daily operating hours • Staff will then provide a new needle disposal container at no cost • For more information call Agnesian HealthCare at (920) 926-4971 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As an added service for those purchasing their diabetic supplies at any Aurora Pharmacy, Aurora will exchange your sharps containers free of charge • An initial sharps container may be purchased for a \$5 fee • For diabetic supplies purchased elsewhere, there is a \$5 fee • Aurora only accepts containers that are $\frac{3}{4}$ full <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Syringes should be at or slightly below the "full" line • Plastic lid must have the lock tab snapped into place • Container must not be placed on the pharmacy counter; staff will put on gloves and take the container directly from you • For more information call Aurora Pharmacy at (920) 907-7260

When the red needle disposal container is full, participants can drop it off at the following locations:
