This receipt is valid until 06-18-2011, unless otherwise cancelled, revoked, suspended or disqualified by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation. If you have not received your Driver License in 30 days, please contact DMV using the information above. Beginning June 1, 2010 no person may operate a motor vehicle in this State unless the owner or driver of the vehicle has liability insurance in effect for the vehicle being operated and carry proof of insurance whenever driving. Law Enforcement may ask for proof of insurance at any traffic stop or accident. Failure to have insurance could result in up to a \$600 fine. Failure to have proof, when requested could result in a \$10 fine. You do not need proof of insurance when registering a vehicle or obtaining a driver license, unless DMV specifically requested proof of financial responsibility (SR-22) after a revocation or suspension. Refer to Wis Stat 344.61-344.65 for full detail.

If an individual does not have an existing driver license or identification card, he or she will leave with only the temporary document. The new product will be printed and mailed in an unmarked envelope (similar to credit card mailings) and will typically arrive within two weeks, well before the temporary driving receipt expires.

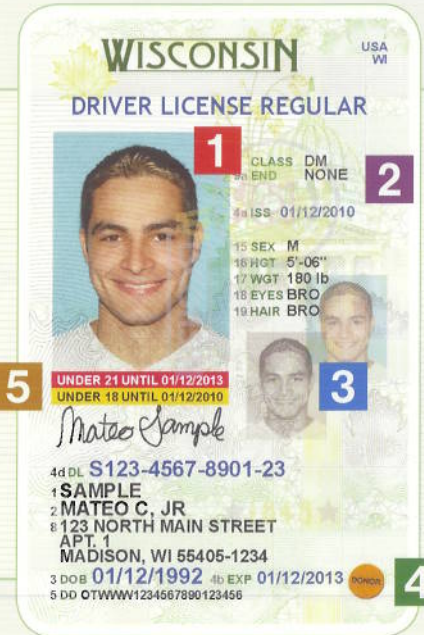


The Wisconsin Division of Motor Vehicles is issuing newly designed driver licenses and identification cards.

These credentials have been designed to

- » avert counterfeiting
- » reduce risk of identity theft
- » decrease fraud
- » meet federally recommended security features

Previously issued driver licenses or identification cards remain valid until their expiration date. At renewal time, the redesigned card will be issued.



1 Front laminate features images of the state seal, "Wisconsin" and "1848" (year Wisconsin became a state)

2 Background security design line work features images of the Wisconsin State Capitol, sugar maple leaves (state tree) and prairie wheat (in recognition of Wisconsin's ecology and heritage)

3 Overlapping ghost images (one color, one laser engraved)

4 Printed organ donor symbol or space for sticker placement after printing

5 For easy reference, "minor" credentials are vertical in format and indicate the dates in which the holder turns 18 and/or 21 years of age

6 Laser-engraved tactile date of birth

7 2-D bar code includes printed data from front of card and 1-D bar code includes an inventory control number

8 Writable surface for anatomical gift statement
